





The Guaranteed Volume of Free Healthcare and the Volume of Healthcare under the System of Obligatory Social Healthcare Insurance in Kazakhstan

- The Guaranteed Volume of Free Healthcare ("GVFH")
 - 1) Emergency medical services;
 - 2) Primary healthcare (e.g., immunization);
 - 3) Outpatient care (HIV, tuberculosis prevention and diagnosis, injuries, poisoning, other acute conditions and diseases according to government lists);
 - 4) Day-patient treatment (diseases according to government lists);
 - 5) Inpatient treatment (diseases according to government lists);
 - 6) Medical rehabilitation in the treatment of the underlying disease as well as of patients with tuberculosis;
 - 7) Palliative care diseases according to government lists);
 - 8) Providing blood products and its components;
 - 9) Pathoanatomical diagnosis;
 - 10) Organ or tissue transplantation and preparation for it:
 - 11) Provision of medicines in certain circumstances (e.g., provision of emergency medical services etc.)

- The Volume of Healthcare under the System of Obligatory Social Healthcare Insurance ("OSHI System")
- 1) Outpatient care (e.g., preventive medical examinations, doctor appointments based on GP's referral);
- 2) Day-patient treatment (other than included in GVFH);
- 3) Inpatient treatment (other than included in GVFH);
- 4) Medical rehabilitation in the treatment of diseases according to the government list;
- 5) Pathoanatomical diagnosis;
- 6) Organ or tissue transplantation and preparation for it;
- 7) Provision of medicines in certain circumstances (e.g., provision of primary and outpatient care based on the government list of diseases;)

- 1) Other services financed from the alternative sources (patients' own funds etc.).




